

## CRA / PEPSI CUP SCORING FORMAT

Scoring will be tallied on the following per round basis

### 1. Round Points

1.1. Points begin accumulating after the first round of your division. Example: If you're in a 16 player division, points awarded begin at the round of 8. In other words, first round losers will not be awarded points in the main draw division.

- 1.1.1. 5 points for getting to the round of 32
- 1.1.2. 10 points for getting to the round of 16
- 1.1.3. 20 points for getting to the round of 8 (quarterfinal)
- 1.1.4. 25 points for getting to the round of 4 (semifinal)
- 1.1.5. 30 points for 2nd
- 1.1.6. 35 points for 1st

**Note: This format is not cumulative ...** for example, if you are playing in a division with 16 players and you win your round of 16 match (advancing to the quarterfinal), you win your round of 8 match (advancing to the semifinal), then *lose* your round of 4 (semifinal) match, the points awarded will be 25 (for getting to the round of 4).

No round points will be awarded for a first round loss.

### 1.2. Round Robin divisions

- 1.2.1. 20 points for 4th
- 1.2.2. 25 points for 3rd
- 1.2.3. 30 points for 2nd
- 1.2.4. 35 points for 1st

2. Consolation points. Automatic consolation rounds are scheduled for first round losses.

- 2.1. 10 points for 2nd
- 2.2. 20 points for 1st

3. Tiebreaker for team standings. In the event a tie exists between two teams, regardless of position, the winner will be determined by total number of matches won in head to head competition between the two clubs. Should a tie still exist it will be the least amount of total points scored against in the same matches.

NOTE: At this year's Pepsi Cup - in combined Open/A divisions – players/teams that lose in the first-round will drop-down into an official "A" bracket – NOT an Open consolation round. From that newly-formed A bracket, first-round losers will be placed into an A consolation round – *if numbers warrant* (an initial Open/A draw of 16 or more).
